- **1 Timothy 2:8 (NIV)**
- **⁸ I want men everywhere to lift up holy hands in prayer, without anger or disputing.**

1. Authentic Disciples are people of integrity.

- **Matthew 6:5-6 (NIV)**
- **⁵ "And when you pray, do not be like the hypocrites, for they love to pray standing in the synagogues and on the street corners to be seen by men. I tell you the truth, they have received their reward in full. ⁶ But when you pray, go into your room, close the door and pray to your Father, who is unseen. Then your Father, who sees what is done in secret, will reward you.**

2. Authentic Disciples are people of modesty and propriety.

- **1 Timothy 2:9-10 (NIV)**
- **⁹ I also want women to dress modestly, with decency and propriety, not with braided hair or gold or pearls or expensive clothes, ¹⁰ but with good deeds, appropriate for women who profess to worship God.**

3. Authentic Disciples are teachable and under proper authority.

- 1 Timothy 2:11-12 (NIV)
- ¹¹ A woman should learn in quietness and full submission. ¹² I do not permit a woman to teach or to have authority over a man; she must be silent.

- Acts 18:26 (NIV)
- ²⁶ He began to speak boldly in the synagogue. When Priscilla and Aquila heard him, they invited him to their home and explained to him the way of God more adequately.

- 1 Timothy 1:19b-20 (NIV)
- ...Some have rejected these and so have shipwrecked their faith. ²⁰ Among them are Hymenaeus and Alexander, whom I have handed over to Satan to be taught not to blaspheme.

- 2 Timothy 3:16 (NIV)
- ¹⁶ All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness,

4. Authentic Disciples are not easily deceived.

- 1 Timothy 2:14 (NLT)
- ¹⁴ And it was the woman, not Adam, who was deceived by Satan, and sin was the result.
- Galatians 3:28 (NIV)
- ²⁸ There is neither Jew nor Greek, slave nor free, male nor female, for you are all one in Christ Jesus.
