

SERMON BASED QUESTIONS

Make a difference this decade – Part 2 – Jan 10, 2010

The questions this week are designed to bring you to a point of dreaming and godly imagining. Try to answer without all the “buts, what ifs, and impossibilities.”

1. Look at the passage on the rich young ruler again. (Luke 18:18-30, Mark 10:17-31 & Matthew 19:16-30)
 - Was there any difference in the way that you viewed the exchange between the young man and Jesus before and after the sermon?
 - What was his particular boundary of fear?
 - What changed for the rich young man as a result of this conversation with Jesus?
 - What did he lose in not facing the fear?
2. What would it have taken for the young man to get out of the visitor center?
3. Do you or have you ever felt like you were at the visitor center?
4. What did it take to get you out of the center?
5. If mortgages, car payments, retirement funds and college funds were not an issue, what would you do that would bring you real joy and fulfillment? (saying what you do now is okay, in fact, it's great)
6. Is there some small or big step that you keep pushing to the back of your head/heart that you may want to pursue this year?
7. Is there a particular boundary of fear that keeps you from following after that? (control, security, success, comfort, or whatever it might be)
8. How can you get unstuck?
9. How can the body of Christ help you get unstuck?
